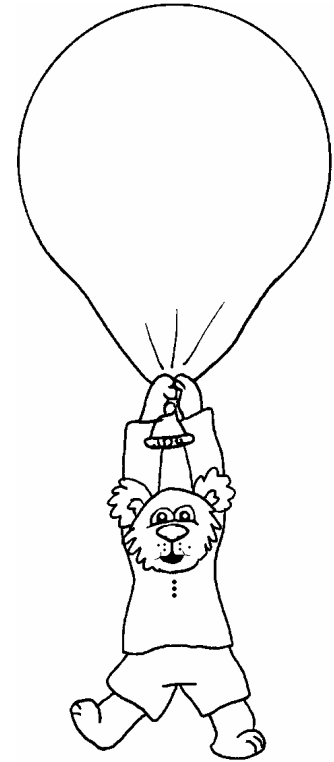

A pronoun is a word used to refer to a person or thing without giving a name; it replaces a noun.

(e.g. he, she, him, them)



Example: He hangs on the balloon.

The word 'he' is a pronoun.

There can be more than one pronoun in a sentence.

Example: He showed her how to hang on the balloon.

The words 'he' and 'her' are pronouns.
